Participant Conduct and Right to Dismiss

Pro Teach Baseball is committed to providing a safe, respectful, and positive environment for all players, coaches, staff, and families. Participants are expected to demonstrate appropriate behaviour, sportsmanship, respect for others, and compliance with the rules and instructions of the Pro Teach Baseball.

Pro Teach Baseball reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to suspend or dismiss any participant whose behaviour is disruptive, disrespectful, unsafe, threatening, abusive, or otherwise detrimental to the program or the well-being of other participants or staff.

Serious misconduct may result in immediate dismissal. Repeated behavioural concerns may also result in dismissal when reasonable efforts to address the behaviour have been unsuccessful.

Dismissal decisions will be made in the best interests of the safety, integrity, and effective operation of Pro Teach baseball.
